
# **ARRL Membership / Renewals**

If you wish to computer log, please bring a laptop computer and I will supply the logging program (if you need one), which is very easy to use and will run on anything from an 8088 to a Windows 2000 machine. I'll have one laptop with me.
- Since any stations wishing a QSL Certificate will need to send a SASE, it will be up to the individual operator as to whether they want to log all contacts. During anticipated pile-ups, logging may become a difficult task.
- Please bring along a set of headphones if you have them to operate your station in an effort to cut down on station to station noise.


